



Frequently Asked Questions about the RMO

1. What is the Russian Math Olympiad (RMO)?

The Russian Math Olympiad is a 75-minute test based on leading math curricula across the world. It is a challenging test in the tradition of European Mathematical Olympiads with complex problems that promote a deeper level of thinking for even the most advanced students. The RMO was originally designed to be an in-person 75-minute test along the lines of a traditional math olympiad. However, in order to ensure the health and safety of our students, our team will be conducting the RMO online this year.

2. What is the duration of the Russian Math Olympiad?

RMO is 75 minutes long and contains 12 questions.

3. How do I get qualified for the Russian Math Olympiad?

In order to qualify for the Russian Math Olympiad the students must successfully complete the International Math Challenge (Round 1)

4. I participated in the International Math Challenge (Round 1), how do i know if i qualified for RMO?

If you qualify, you will receive an invitation to participate in RMO via email in the middle of March.

5. I got qualified for the Russian Math Olympiad (RMO) When can I take it?

RMO will be held the week of April 5th. You will receive an email letting you know about the date and time of the test.

6. What if I cannot make it to the Russian Math Olympiad? Can I take the test on another day?

Unfortunately, you will not be able to take the test on another day. We hope that you can plan in advance.

7. What device can I take the RMO on?

The RMO can be taken only on desktop computers, laptops, and tablets.

8. What happens if we have technical difficulties/internet problems during the online test?

In case you lose connectivity, your test will be paused and once your connection is restored, you can continue the test.

9. Can I find math problems from previous years to practice for the Russian Math Olympiad?

Yes, you can find all problems and answers from previous years in your dashboard as soon as you log in into your dashboard.

10. When will I get the results of the Russian Math Olympiad?

The results of the RMO will be announced sometime in May. You will receive an email with the score and placement.

11. Do the students receive certificates and medals?

The results of the Russian Math Olympiad will be based on percentile and students will be awarded certificates and Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals accordingly.

12. Where can I find information about cut offs and percentiles?

The cut offs and percentile information will be posted on RSM Foundation website in May once the results for RMO are finalized.

13. What is the RSM Foundation?
