

Frequently Asked Questions about the IMC Round 2

1. What is the International Math Contest Round 2 (IMC Round 2)?

The International Math Contest Round 2 is a 75-minute test based on leading math curricula across the world. It is a challenging test in the tradition of European Mathematical Olympiads with complex problems that promote a deeper level of thinking for even the most advanced students. The IMC Round 2 was originally designed to be an in-person 75-minute test along the lines of a traditional math olympiad, but this year we are going to expand the contest by conducting it both in-person and online. The Online option will be offered to international students, RSM Online students and students who live far away from our local branches.

2. What is the duration of the International Math Contest Round 2?

IMC Round 2 is 75 minutes long and contains 12 questions.

3. How do I get qualified for the International Math Contest Round 2?

In order to qualify for the International Math Contest Round 2 the students must successfully complete the International Math Challenge (Round 1)

4. I participated in the International Math Challenge (Round 1), how do I know if I qualified for IMC Round 2?

If you qualify, you will receive an invitation to participate in IMC Round 2 via email in the middle of March.

5. I got qualified for the International Math Contest Round 2. When can I take it?

IMC Round 2 will be held in the second week of April. You will receive an email letting you know about the date and time of the test.

6. What if I cannot make it to the International Math Contest Round 2? Can I take the test on another day?

Unfortunately, you will not be able to take the test on another day. We hope that you can plan in advance.

7. What device can I take the International Math Contest Round 2 on?

The IMC Round 2 can be taken only on desktop computers, laptops, and tablets.

8. What happens if we have technical difficulties/internet problems during the online test?

In case you lose connectivity, your test will be paused and once your connection is restored, you can continue the test.

9. Can I find math problems from previous years to practice for the International Math Contest Round 2?

Yes, you can find all problems and answers from previous years in your dashboard as soon as you log in into your account.

10. When will I get the results of the International Math Contest Round 2?

The results of the IMC Round 2 will be announced about 3 weeks after the Final Round. Any changes to the timeline will be posted on the website.

11. Do the students receive certificates and medals?

The results of the International Math Contest Round 2 will be based on percentile and students will be awarded certificates and Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals accordingly.

12. Where can I find information about cut offs and percentiles?

The cut offs and percentile information will be posted on RSM Foundation website once the results for International Math Contest Round 2 are finalized.

13. What is the RSM Foundation?
